

Painting for Beginners

Course Outline

Description: This course is designed to be ongoing, with students encouraged to re-enrol as many times as they like, to continue their painting and learning. The paint materials used in this course are acrylic, watercolour, ink and pastels.

Course Content

- Observation of still life to make representational imagery
- Composition and formatting
- Colour Theory
- Palette layout
- Types of paints, mediums and brushes
- Types of application and support
- Setting a painting out from start to finish

Outcomes: By the end of this course you will have:

- Acquired basic painting ability
- Become practiced in recognising good composition
- An understanding of tone
- Experience with colour mixing and ability to perceive and name warm/cool, transparent/ opaque colours
