Course Outline

Description:

This is an extension of the Level 2 course. It is recommended that students complete the Level 2 course first or have studied German to a similar level.

Week	Content
1	Revision of work covered in Level 2
2	Booking a hotel room, comparing different hotels and describing location of buildings.
3	Fashion and clothing, describing items of personal appearance and saying what clothes you like.
4	Invitations and talking about giving things to people, and asking for advice.
5	Health, discussing health, naming parts of the body and aches and pains.
6	Weather conditions and past holidays.
7	Making and answering phone calls, saying what belongs to whom.
8	Job adverts and writing a CV.
9	Talking about German speaking countries and historical events.
10	Revision and practical application: celebrating acquired knowledge German style.
